### Cowcatcher Division 1 Program for November 2, 2019

#### **Clinic Overview**

Making Blacktop Roads with Jeff Palmer & On the Road with the Cowcatcher Crew Note: So that our members will have the opportunity to visit the UP 4014 Big Boy while in the area during Union Pacific's "The Great Race Across the Southwest", the Cowcatcher Division November meeting will take place on the FIRST Saturday of the month, at 10:00am on November 2<sup>nd</sup>, at the Forest Hill Civic and Convention Center.

The November 2<sup>nd</sup> clinic will be presented by Jeff Palmer, MMR #620. Jeff has had a lifelong interest in trains and has been involved in the NMRA - Lone Star Region since 2007. Jeff currently serves as Secretary for the LSR and is active in supporting both Trinity River Division and Cowcatcher Division events, and is a regular participant at the monthly D1 meetings. In the past, Jeff has presented Clinics to D1 in Ground Cover & Terrain Techniques and Static Grass. Amongst his many interests in model railroading, Jeff has a special passion for modeling realistic scenery.

On November 2<sup>nd</sup> Jeff will present a clinic on Making Asphalt/Blacktop Roads. Making roads was one of the most requested topics from our Clinic Survey, and Jeff will provide us with a wealth of information on the subject. Jeff will discuss resources and techniques for adding realistic asphalt roadways to a layout. In the future, Jeff will continue with presentations on making roads that represent using other road and parking lot building materials.

"On the road again" All interested parties are invited to join the caravan to see UP Big Boy 4014 in Palestine, TX on Saturday, November 9<sup>th</sup>. We will meet in the parking lot of the Texas Western Model Railroad Club at 8:30am and depart promptly at 9:00am. Our arrival will allow time for lunch and/or a visit to the Palestine Railroad Heritage Center before the Big Boy arrives. Open from 9:30am – 4:30pm, and located across the street from the UP Yard, the Railroad Heritage Center offers a beautiful HO scale layout depicting the railroads that serviced the area, a UP Caboose and Depot. The Palestine Farmers Market is also on the site, overlooking the UP Yard. UP 4014 is scheduled to arrive in Palestine at approximately 2:00pm and will overnight in the yard until 8:00am Sunday morning.

If you have not already done so, make sure to register for the upcoming 2-part "Scratch Building a Flat Car" clinic in January 2020. It is important that everyone that is interested in participating in the clinic registers by the December 12<sup>th</sup> (12/12) deadline so that enough clinic kit components can be ordered and received on time for the January 11<sup>th</sup>, 2020 D1 meeting. Cost of the clinic will be in the neighborhood of \$30.00 per kit, and the division will offset the cost of each kit with a \$10.00 subsidy, dropping the participant expense to around \$20.00. For those pursuing their MMR, this clinic will help to fulfill the requirements for the Model Railroad Equipment category, Master Builder – Cars, Achievement Program Certificate. The 30' wooden flat car that will be built can be replicated and used as the basis to expand upon to scratch build a Gondola, Boxcar, etc. More information on the clinic will be provided as it becomes available. If you are interested in participating in the clinic but cannot attend the D1 November  $2^{nd}$  meeting, please contact Joe Leising by email at Joe@Leising.com or by calling 817 - 312 - 6615, and provide your name, scale, email address and telephone number.

B

ack to the AP program. As Lorrie and I write these articles every month, we're also working on our AP's. The write ups / paperwork involved with these

awards can be quite tiresome but they are very important and needed. We're to the point that we have all our rolling stock built, 4 kit builds and 4 scratch builds each but by putting off our write ups, we've made it difficult on ourselves trying to remember what we did while constructing our cars. All of Lorries scratch builds were all less than 2 years ago, some of my scratch building goes back 25+ years. In the early 1990's there was a hobby shop that went out of business in Haltom City on 28th Street. I bought handfuls of scratch building supplies and kits from that hobby shop and still have lots of those supplies and kits today. I found it fun to build a car or two in between building structures for The Texas Western Model Railroad Club. After Lorrie started building structures in 2006, I encouraged her to build an HOn3 car kit. She chose the Tiffany boxcar by Binkley Models.





She thought the Tiffany car was cute and she's right, it is kind of cute (it's on our layout). Most of these cars are a joy to build and give the builder a sense of accomplishment in just a short time.

All this sounds great right? Well, the problem that I (we) have come across is doing the write ups for these cars long after they were built. It's not easy trying to remember what the heck we did a year ago or twenty years ago? I can look at the underframes and remember that the doohickey is connected to the thingy and later it was painted some shade of brown. Taking photos of our work last century wasn't nearly as easy as it is today. When you have notes and pictures to use as a reference, it makes doing your AP write ups a breeze! The AP program is a great way for us modelers to learn. What I learned in all of this is that taking notes and pictures while working on your AP's is a

good idea. 🤙

## The Dining Car

This month's Dining Car features a breakfast treat you'll want to try:

### French Toast A La Santa Fe

perfected by Fred Harvey in 1918 for the Santa Fe Railroad.

The Fred Harvey recipe was reputed to be the best of all the railroad French toast recipes. Although it looks terrific to me, you'll need to be the judge.

### Ingredients

• 2 thick slices white bread (Texas Toast will do just fine)

- 2 eggs
- 1/2 cup light cream
- Pinch of salt
- 1/2 cup cooking oil

### **Instructions:**

Preheat oven to 400 degrees. You'll need a 12" skillet for frying the toast, a baking sheet, small mixing bowl, and a whisk. Heat the cooking oil on high in the 12 inch cast iron skillet. Cut bread slices diagonally into triangles. In a small bowl, combine eggs, cream, and salt and beat well. Soak bread in the egg mixture until fully saturated. Fry the slices in the hot oil for about two minutes per side or until golden brown. Drain on paper towels. Transfer to the baking sheet and bake for 4-6 minutes. Sprinkle with powdered sugar and top with cinnamon and apple sauce, jelly, or maple syrup. This being Texas, a side of grilled ham or sausage will make this dish unbeatable.

This recipe makes two servings.
