Program Overview

Making your structures look real. With Mike Corley

Join us on the November 14th Zoom Meeting with an amazing clinic by Mike Corley began his journey with trains when he was five years old. Like many of us, he had a Lionel set. His real adventure began in 1968 when his wife gave him a HO train set for Christmas. In those early days, he focused on operations and learning how to build a layout. Over the years he has built four layouts and participated in the construction of the Texas Western Model Railroad club's Houston area. He has attended clinics by Dave Frary, David Revelia, Brian Nolan, Doug Foscale, and Malcom Furlow. These clinics gave him the confidence and skills to begin creating craftsman style structures, models, and scenery and making them look real. Mike lives in Granbury with his wife and also enjoys Freemasonry, woodworking, fly fishing, and cooking. Mike was also a featured presenter during the 2020 NMRA-X Convention.

The objective of the clinic is to introduce and review different techniques for making structures look more realistic. This is not a weathering clinic, but focuses on demonstrating techniques including photographs, pigments, paint colors, and details.

From the Editor's WorkBench

he Texas Western Track Gang Part 2

Our scenery crew at the TWMRC has spent the fall months painting and detailing the rails and ties on our 53" level. To model the effects of rails and rail ties weathering, we used 3 shades of gray and 3 shades of brown with craft paints from craft stores for the ties. We used a combination of rattle cans flat brown and craft paints to weather the rust and dirt common to the rail hues. We're getting rid of the unrealistic nickel silver rails and uniform brown plastic ties, and we are adding more realism to an often overlooked detail in HO scale track modeling, but this technique would work with any scale track.

In early November, with help from Jim Archer, our crew began gluing light gray ballast down on the tower 55 tracks. Next up, we will be adding some changes to the landscaping creating changes in elevation and adding some shallow ditches, dirt and grass to our scenes around the tower. Mike Mackey has printed several electrical outdoor cabinets and battery boxes that powered turnouts around the tower. These were made with Mike's 3D printer. We are going to model these devices that existed around the busy interlocking tower in Ft. Worth, TX in our era. This will be shown in a future workbench article.




