Making Styrene Look Like Wood With Bob Brendle

Bob first became interested in model railroading with an O-scale layout that his father had built, and by the young age of 16, won his first blue ribbon at the LSR Convention for a complete Maintenance of Way Train. This encouraged him to continue modeling and after graduating from college, began modeling in HO scale and ultimately in HOn3. Bob has had several articles published in Railroad Model Craftsman and Narrow Gauge Annual magazines as well as many trade publications in his professional career in architecture. Bob has presented several clinics at annual LSR and National Narrow Gauge Conventions. Bob models the *Westcliff & Alton Railway Company*.





Effective March 31, 2020, in accordance with the policy adopted by the National Model Railroad Association (NMRA) at its board meeting on March 7, 2020, Division 1 of the Lone Star Region of the NMRA, commonly known as the "Cowcatcher Division", will require anyone under the age of 18, wishing to attend any division event, to be personally escorted by their parent or legal guardian.
