



### This month's clinic:

Using Right-of-Way Signs, and Laying Backwoods Track.

The November Clinic will be full of useful tips for modeling optimum layouts.

Paul Buhrke will help you navigate your Model Railroad by using Right-of-Way signs just like the highway system uses. Paul got his start in model railroading so early, he was teething on his crib while watching the DL&W electrics pass by his apartment window in New Jersey. There are pictures from 1958 of Paul operating an 027 layout built by his dad in Illinois. Years later, Paul switched to HO (sorry Dad!). Over the ensuing years, Paul modelled in Hon3, HO, Sn3, On2 and now in HOn3. The real thrill for Paul was in 1980. He was hired by Seaboard Coast line as a Trainman/Conductor. In 1989 he was called up by AMTRAK and after a total of 33 years, he retired. Yes indeed, he got paid to play trains for a very long time. Paul has used and depended on a lot of "Right Away" signs. Don't miss the opportunity to learn what he knows about them.

Rich Mossholder (Mossy) will be describing his technique for laying backwoods tracks. Mossy is from Santa Rosa, California. He has been modeling railroads since he was four. He has built several layouts in scales ranging from N to O. He has been a member of the North Coast Narrow Gaugers HOn3 modular club since 2004. He is currently building his HOn3 empire in his basement. After looking at the progress of it at www.silvertonguesouthern.com, you will want to be sure to hear his tips.





Effective March 31, 2020, in accordance with the policy adopted by the National Model Railroad Association (NMRA) at its board meeting on March 7, 2020, Division 1 of the Lone Star Region of the NMRA, commonly known as the "Cowcatcher Division", will require anyone under the age of 18, wishing to attend any division event, to be personally escorted by their parent or legal guardian. Additionally, the parent or legal guardian must sign a current document stating that they will remain in visual contact with their minor at all times.
