Dead Rail – Radio Controlled Battery Powered Model Trains

Make plans to join us for our monthly Zoom meeting at 10:00am on Saturday, March 13th. Our program will be presented by Pete Steinmetz, Division Director of the Pacific Southwest Region, San Diego Division.

Pete has been an avid modeler since childhood. He modeled HO scale for many years, worked with N scale for a short while, and ultimately transitioned to On30. While in On30 he discovered the joy of operating trains with Battery Power and Radio Control. Pete is the owner of Dead Rail Installs and is one of the founding members of the Dead Rail Society. In addition to Dead Rail, Pete has done considerable research in Weathering Techniques using mixed media. He has been especially interested in techniques used by military modelers.

Are you tired of having to clean track for smooth running trains? Would you like to build a layout without having to wire the track? Are you interested in controlling your trains with Battery Power? As the interest in Dead Rail grows and matures, there are more opportunities to help people make the transition to Dead Rail. Pete will discuss the various available Dead Rail Systems and their various advantages, as well as safe batteries and their charging systems.

Effective March 31, 2020, in accordance with the policy adopted by the National Model Railroad Association (NMRA) at its board meeting on March 7, 2020, Division 1 of the Lone Star Region of the NMRA, commonly known as the "Cowcatcher Division", will require anyone under the age of 18, wishing to attend any division event, to be personally escorted by their parent or legal guardian. Additionally, the parent or legal guardian must sign a current document stating that they will remain in visual contact with their minor at all times.
