Afterwards we will be introduced via Zoom to James Winebrenner of J&A Custom Trains to discuss hand-laid turnouts. James has been making custom handlaid turnouts in every scale and design, including dual-gauge, for over 25 years. James also works with other aspects of model railroading.

Afterwards we will have our annual (except for last year during the pandemic) cook-out in the backyard of the Texas Western Club House. We look forward to seeing you there to add to the camaraderie with your fellow model railroaders. During the cook-out we will also have a live feed to the Lone Star Region Board of Directors meeting.

Now is the time to start preparing for the Scratch Building a Flatcar Clinic in July. For those that have purchased their parts package through the division or will be providing their own parts, start gathering the following tools for Part 1 of 2 of the Flatcar Clinic:

Exacto Knife with several sharp #11 blades.

Exacto #17 Chisel Blade.

Cutting Matt.

NWSL Chopper or a Razor Saw with a Miter Box (Chopper is highly recommended). If using a Chopper, make sure that it has a sharp blade.

220 Grit or higher Sandpaper (a 220 Grit Sanding Sponge works really well).

Course Emory Board, 60 – 120 grit.

Glue – Yellow Carpenters Glue is preferred and highly recommended. Elmer's White Glue (NOT School Glue) or Aileen's Tackey Glue can also be used.

Glue Applicator. Can use a Toothpick, Sewing Pin, Micro-Brush, etc.

Shot Glass is recommended but not required. Concaved bottom of a Shot Glass allows for an area to place glue which can then be easily accessed.

Acrylic Paint (black, grey or boxcar red).

Small Paint Brush.

India Ink (NOT Acrylic Ink) and a pint of 91% Isopropyl Alcohol.

Leak proof container for mixing the India Ink and Isopropyl Alcohol

Scale Ruler.

Paper Towels.

Pencil with a sharp point.







Effective March 31, 2020, in accordance with the policy adopted by the National Model Railroad Association (NMRA) at its board meeting on March 7, 2020, Division 1 of the Lone Star Region of the NMRA, commonly known as the "Cowcatcher Division", will require anyone under the age of 18, wishing to attend any division event, to be personally escorted by their parent or legal guardian. Additionally, the parent or legal guardian must sign a current document stating that they will remain in visual contact with their minor at all times.
