This month's clinic:

Scratch Building A Flat Car with Duane Richardson, MMR

Nineteen months after the originally scheduled date (thanks to Covid-19), the Scratch Building a Flatcar Make-n-Take Clinic is going to take place on Saturday, July 10, 2021. Duane Richardson, MMR, from the Trinity River Division 3, will be taking us through a step-by-step process on scratch building a wooden flatcar.

The foundation of a flatcar is the basis for building other types of rolling-stock, such as a Gondola, Box Car, Reefer and Tank Car. Collectively, scratch building three of these four different types of cars, plus a car from a passenger train (which includes an Express Reefer), will fulfill the scratch building portion to earn a "Cars" Certificate in the NMRA Achievement Program (all four car types must merit).

The July meeting will be Part 1 of a two-part clinic. In Part 1, we will scratch build the under-frame and deck. Due to the UP 4014 Big Boy making an appearance in Fort Worth on August 14th, Part 2 of the clinic will be held on the first Saturday in August, August 7th at 10:00am at the Texas Western Model Railroad Club. If you would like to volunteer to assist with the Big Boy's visit to Fort Worth, contact Dennis Wright, Assistant Program Manager, at dlwright5711@att.net.

A parts-package will be distributed during the July 10th meeting to the individuals that registered for the clinic in 2019. An email has been sent to those individuals with a Tools List that will be required to complete the flatcar construction. If you did not receive the Tools List contact Joe Leising at Joe@Leising.com. 





Effective March 31, 2020, in accordance with the policy adopted by the National Model Railroad Association (NMRA) at its board meeting on March 7, 2020, Division 1 of the Lone Star Region of the NMRA, commonly known as the "Cowcatcher Division", will require anyone under the age of 18, wishing to attend any division event, to be personally escorted by their parent or legal guardian. Additionally, the parent or legal guardian must sign a current document stating that they will remain in visual contact with their minor at all times.
