

This month's clinics:

"Roads of Different Types and Construction Techniques" with Jeff Palmer

This month's clinic will address different road types that have been studied and modeled. Jeff will show actual, prototype photos of these several road types and explain the basics of what makes them up. He will describe the materials and tools needed to model the differing roads. It will be a clinic far removed from just painting a brown, gray, or black band for a road on a flat surface. The road types he will cover include:

- Dirt roads
- Gravel roads
- Black Top roads Asphalt
- Concrete roads

Jeff Palmer retired after he spent 50 years developing software, and 25 years as a college professor. During that time, as now, he is a "modeler" meaning he loves to build structures, bridges, scenery, and locos. More specifically, his interest is in logging and mining, which by definition means, he likes narrow gauge. It's the free form and ruggedness that surrounds logging and mining railroads scenery and landscape.

Jeff is always on the lookout for new techniques, and tools that improve the hobby. Model railroading allows him to expand his skill set, work with his hands, and share with his friends, the things he has learned. Several of Jeff's modeling articles have been published in model railroad magazines. About 2 years ago, Jeff completed his MMR (Master Model Railroader) certificate from the NMRA. During that journey, he had the privilege of meeting many of the modelers he looked up to like Gil Freitag, Duane Richardson, Chuck Ellis, George Sellios, Marc LaChey, Dave Revelia, Dave Frary, Scott Mason, and others. His goal is to be recognized in this group of modelers someday.

Division One of the Lone Star NMRA Region

Effective March 31, 2020, in accordance with the policy adopted by the National Model Railroad Association (NMRA) at its board meeting on March 7, 2020, Division 1 of the Lone Star Region of the NMRA, commonly known as the "Cowcatcher Division", will require anyone under the age of 18, wishing to attend any division event, to be personally escorted by their parent or legal guardian. Additionally, the parent or legal guardian must sign a current document stating that they will remain in visual contact with their minor at all times.
