

An extremely successful NMRA convention just finished at the Gaylord Texan, and I wanted to recap the size and benefits of the Convention from the perspective of a first time National Convention attendee.

First the stats, the convention had over 950 registrants from 5 continents, 7 prototype bus tours, 7 general interest activities, Project Linus, 5 general interests tours, 5 layout bus tours with each tour visiting at least 4 layouts, 38 layouts in the areas open during the self-driving tours, a Contest Room, and over 250 hours of clinics. That is a lot to see and do in seven days.

Congratulations to the convention committee for a job well done and for a smooth-running convention.

As frequently mentioned, Division 1 has two program themes this year:

- Making your Model Railroad dreams a reality.
- If you do nothing, expect nothing as a result.

The clinics and layout tours certainly stretched my comfort zone and presented ideas and concepts that will help make my model railroad dreams a reality.

Things I learned and can put to use, immediately are:

- Using artists' chalk to paint and weather detail castings.
