

NMRA POLICY STATEMENT

EFFECTIVE MARCH31, 2020, IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE POLICY ADOPTED BY THE NATIONAL MODEL RAILROAD ASSOCIATION AT ITS BOARD MEETING ON MARCH 7, 2020, DIVISION 1 OF THE LONE STAR REGION OF THE NMRA, COMMONLY KNOWN AS THE COWCATCHER DIVISION. WILL REQUIRE ANYONE UNDER THE AGE OF 18, WISHING TO ATTEND ANY DIVISION EVENT. TO BE PERSONALLY ESCORTED BY THEIR PARENT ORLEGAL GUARDIAN.

ADDITIONALLY, PARENT OR LEGAL GUARDIAN MUST SIGN A CURRENT DOCUMENT STATING THAT THEY WILL REMAIN IN VISUAL CONTACT WITH THEIR MINOR AT ALL TIMES.



SEPTEMBER CLINIC

Title: 3D Printing and Model Railroading

ERIC SMITH

Eric has been a model railroader since age 7, when his older brother and he received an HO oval set for Christmas. It soon became his first 4'x8' layout with multiple sidings and terrain. Eric rode his first train in the summer of 1968, going roundtrip from Ardmore, Oklahoma to Houston, Texas on Amtrak to see his oldest brother.

Model railroading has always been a part of Eric's life, and lately he has been assisting others build their home layouts. He is currently working on his 3rd layout, 2nd N Scale, the "Biltsmore & Ohno" Railroad (B&O). He has been collecting and modelling in N scale for about 40 years.

For 40 years, Eric worked as a 3D graphics Software Engineer for Fortune 500 and start-up companies in telecom, medical and aerospace. With his 3D Software Engineering and modelling background, 3D printing was a natural extension of his modelling capabilities, combining it with model railroading. Since 2018, Eric has been the owner of Scale Railroad Models, a 3D model railroad building kit manufacturer company.




